



Opportunity for SME's to be awarded with SSETA funded BBBEE Certificates

Which companies qualify?

- SSETA levy paying Small and Medium companies with an annual turnover of less than R5million.
- These companies are referred to as EME's (Exempt Micro Enterprises). They are exempt from the rating process and get an automatic Level 4 contribution which is 100% compliance with BBBEE.
- The first 1750 companies to respond, we will be using the first come, first serve principle.

Why is this important for companies?

- Although BBBEE compliance is optional, it is in the best interest. For micro enterprises it presents a significant opportunity for them to compete in the BBBEE environment.
- As a BBBEE compliant company, you stand a better chance of tendering with the government.
- Most importantly, the companies will not be liable for the cost of the exemption certificates, SSETA will be covering ALL costs. It makes business sense to take advantage of such an opportunity.
