MEDICAL AND HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT FOR THE 2018 ACADEMIC YEAR**

An **opportunity for 50 learners** to acquire skills, knowledge and workplace experience in the field of Funeral Parlour, Medical and Hazardous Waste Management for twelve-month **for the 2018 academic year**.

Applications Open: 15th December 2017 and Closing: 15th January 2018 @ 16h00

Services SETA in partnership with the University of Limpopo (UL), has introduced an exciting 12-month learnership and certificate programme aimed to present contemporary techniques that will enhance efficiency in Funeral Parlour, Medical and Hazardous Waste Management.

The learnership and certificate programme consist of the following:

- Six Months of Funeral Parlour Certificate (January to June 2018) inclusive of theoretical (30%) and work integrated learning component (70%).
- Six Months of Medical and Hazardous Waste Management Certificate (July to December 2018) inclusive of theoretical (30%) and work Integrated learning (70%).

Please note: Certification will be issued on completion of the full 12 month.

Target Learners

The programme is aimed at aspiring and/or learners who are currently working in funeral parlour industry, cemetery operators, manufacturers of burial and memorial products, medical and hazardous waste collectors, disposal site staff, medical and nursing professionals, hospital and related environment cleaning staff.

Minimum Requirements

- South Africans who are in possession of the Grade 12/Standard 10 with Matric and a pass in English, Physical Science and Life Science or Biology; or
- South Africans who have successfully completed the National Certificate in Vocational Studies (NQF Level 4); or
- South Africans who have successfully completed a further Education and Training Certificate (NQF Level 4) and
- South Africans with Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) based on minimum of 3 years relevant working experience in the funeral parlour or medical and hazardous waste management.

Please note: Learners will be required to sign a bursary agreement with the Services SETA.

Application process:

- A certified copy of South African Identity Document.
- Certified copy of matric certificate.
- Original letter from the employer in a company letter head with company stamp (if available) and a contactable reference.
